Oral mucositis is one of the most common side effects following **radio and chemotherapy** in patients with **head and neck cancer**.

The severity and duration of mucositis depend on the radiation source, cumulative dosage, dose intensity, and the volume of irradiated mucosa. Lesions are primarily observed on the mobile oral mucosa, the buccal mucosa, and the lateral and ventral surfaces of the tongue.

contains 20% Acemannan, forming a protective barrier on the mucosa and soothing pain associated with mucositis.



Althea Phytocomplex:

creates a protective mucosal barrier that alleviates symptoms and shields against irritation.
